<p style="text-align: center;">School Policy Reviews</p> <p>Like many New Zealand schools, our school works with SchoolDocs to create a website for our policies and procedures. SchoolDocs updates, modifies, or creates policies in response to changes in legislation or Ministry guidelines, significant events, reviews/requests from schools, and regular reviewing from the SchoolDocs team. Our school board has the opportunity to view changes/additions and comment on them before they are implemented.
